Shigohei Falls

Location Koduradani, Gosen City Date of Designation August 22, 2000

Shigohei Falls is located on one of the streams that empties into the Hayade River, with a depth of approximately 30 meters and a width of 1.5 meters at the top of the falls. The mountains of Kawachi formed a deep V-shaped valley due to erosion by the Haide River, and the stream flowing into the valley also carves a steep valley. This waterfall was created by the erosion of the deep valley and water, and represents the steepness and blessed nature of the Kawachi Valley, as well as the beautiful scenery that is in harmony with the surrounding nature.

[Attention]

- 1. The entrance is on the right hand side of this sign. (It takes about 15 minuteson foot to reach the Shigohei Falls.)

 The path is not paved, so please watch your step and follow the signs.
- 2. Be aware that leeches may be in the grass.
- 3.Please refrain from needlessly picking up plants and flowers along the way to the waterfall.
